She has been in a professional reined cowhorse program her whole life and has earned points with the ARHA and AQHA. She has a willing stop, easy lead changes, and neck reins great. Judy has been shown in Minnesota, Nebraska, Texas, Wyoming, and South Dakota. She truly has seen the sights and has a long resume for her young age. Most recently, she has started roping in the heeling box and is doing amazing. She is very quiet in the box, tracks well, and doesn't get hot.
