If you're looking for a highly trained horse with all the buttons, a big stop, spins, lead changes off your seat, and the proven performance record to follow, look no further than Buckshot.

This gelding is a money earner in heeling, barrel racing, and steer wrestling as a haze horse. He was started in the tie-down and can be used all day long in the breakaway or on the head side. The true versatility of this horse is also accompanied by his Reserve National Championship title in Jr. Working Cow, and 3rd Place National Championship in the ApHC 3yo Snaffle Bit Reining Futurity. His truly correct base of training allowed him to transfer into any event we threw at him.

This horse is a strong and gritty personality, he wants to do his job every time. Buckshot doesn't need very many cues to execute what you're asking of him. He is on the more sensitive side to the touch, just by nature of the bloodline and caliber of horse he is. This can result in some snortiness and cautious behavior with haltering, but we pay no mind to it and just move slow. He still remains extremely gentle. You can ride him with or without spurs, spade bit or snaffle, it doesn't matter to him, he responds the same and he doesn't overly react to discipline. However, over time he may become tense, expectably. Despite that, he has maintained the ability to practice a lot of steers and still score, not anticipate, and keep working. When it comes to barrel racing, he is strong to the first barrel and needs a lot of checking, 2nd and 3rd he rates great. He doesn't do as well with multiple practice runs in the barrels, enjoys slow work though.

In the summer he has a very fine and pure golden coat, and he has silver in his mane and tail. Just due to normal wear and tear, he does thrive a lot better with stifle and hock injections if you intend to use him frequently. He is not currently up to date on either of those injections, but he rides fine with light workload right now without them. His biggest fault is he doesn't like picking up his hind legs for the farrier, the right side is the worst. This is greatly attributed to a lot of pacing he did during a stage of his life, hence the need for injections. Please contact us directly for more information on this.
